

(NEW) WAC 388-116-4040

Transportation Mileage Reimbursement

(1) An eligible beneficiary may select a family member or friend to provide transportation to the beneficiary. The family member or friend may be reimbursed up to the maximum rate per month for miles traveled with the beneficiary at the current IRS mileage reimbursement rate under WAC 388-116-4020.

(2) To request transportation mileage reimbursement, the eligible beneficiary must be enrolled with the financial management services vendor and follow their requirements for processing and issuing reimbursement.

(3) To receive reimbursement for transportation mileage provided to an eligible beneficiary, the family member or friend must:

(a) Be enrolled with the financial management services vendor;

(b) Provide proof of a current valid driver's license;

(c) Provide proof of up-to-date auto insurance;

(d) Provide proof of vehicle registration; and

(e) Be over the age of 18.

(4) The family member or friend must:

(a) Document mileage traveled with the eligible beneficiary and the date of service; and

(b) Submit the documentation to the financial management services vendor no more than 60 days after the date the transportation was provided.

(5) The family member or friend is not required to be a long-term services and supports provider under WAC 388-116-3010.

(NEW) WAC 388-116-4050

Financial management services vendor purchases on behalf of eligible beneficiary

(1) An eligible beneficiary may request the financial management services vendor purchase allowable adaptive equipment and technology under WAC 388-116-1010 on their behalf.

(2) When a financial management services vendor makes a purchase on behalf of an eligible beneficiary, the financial management service vendor must follow WAC 388-116-4020 for maximum rates for adaptive equipment and technology.

(3) The financial management services vendor must not purchase adaptive equipment and technology for a beneficiary using a consumer-to-consumer online platform.
