ⁱ Monthly recurring (RB) means the units/dollars are for each month in the date span. Span multiple (MB) means if the authorization is for multiple months, the units/dollars are spread over the entire span of months and can be billed multiple times within the span.

Span single (SB) means if the authorization is for multiple months, the units/dollars are for the entire span of months and can only be billed one time (on a single date of service).
