| Department of Social and Health Services | DSHS |
|--|------|
| Employment Security Department | ESD |
| Health Care Authority | HCA |
| Long-term services and supports | LTSS |
| Revised Code of Washington | RCW |
| Washington Cares Fund / WA Cares Fund | WCF |
| Washington Administrative Code | WAC |



RCW 50B.04.020(3)

The department of social and health services shall:

(c) Register long-term services and supports providers that meet minimum qualifications;

Minimum Qualifications

- The provider must:
 - Have a valid license for the service(s) they want to provide beneficiaries
 - Pass a criminal background check
 - Have an active WA Cares contract for the service(s) they want to provide beneficiaries
 - Agree to the operational standards set by the program

Operational Standards

- Operational standards will be adopted in rule
- Examples:
 - Hold liability insurance
 - Cooperate with monitoring activities
 - Use ProviderOne to submit preauthorizations to beneficiaries and submit claims for payment of services
 - Submit payment claims within 60-days of service
 - Notify the department if a beneficiary passes away or has a major incident during service provision
 - Notify the department of changes in ownership
 - Notify the department of address change
 - Notify the department if no longer choose to be registered
 - Notify the department if no longer meet the minimum qualifications
 - Report suspected abuse, abandonment, neglect, or financial exploitation to Adult Protective Services and Law Enforcement when applicable

Becoming a registered provider

- Complete an application
 - Provide proof of meeting minimum qualifications for the service(s) they want to provide
 - Provide documentation necessary to obtain a DSHS contract for WA Cares Fund Program
- Complete a background check
 - A Character, Competency, and Suitability review may be needed for background checks with prior criminal convictions
- Obtain a DSHS contract for WA Cares Fund Program
- Once registered, a provider will be listed on the Community Living Connection website and beneficiaries can choose to work with the provider.



Denial or discontinuation

- Denial means a registration application was not approved by DSHS for a provider to become registered.
- Discontinuation means DSHS or a provider ended the provider registration

RCW 50B.04.020(3)

The department of social and health services shall:

(d) Discontinue the registration of long-term services and supports providers that: (i) Fail to meet the minimum qualifications applicable in law to the approved service that they provide; or (ii) violate the operational standards of the program;

Reasons DSHS may deny or discontinue a registration

- Provider no longer meets minimum qualifications (e.g., no license, failed background check)
- Past contracts with DSHS terminated for cause
- Declining to sign a contract or agree to the terms of a contract


Requirements for a provider who wishes to discontinue registration

The provider must:

- Notify the department
- Notify any beneficiaries currently receiving services
- Maintain records during the service timeframe as required

RCW 50B.04.120(1), Appeal of determinations

 Determinations made by the health care authority or the department of social and health services under this chapter, including determinations regarding functional eligibility or related to registration of long-term services and supports providers, are subject to appeal in accordance with chapter 34.05 RCW.
