Rulemaking updates

- A public hearing is scheduled for August 5th, 2025 for general provisions, beneficiary eligibility determinations, and requirements to provide approved services. This packet includes:
 - Definitions of key terms used throughout the new chapter, including definitions of approved services.
 - Eligibility requirements for beneficiaries to receive approved services.
 - Requirements for providers of approved services, including minimum qualifications, background check requirements, and application requirements.
