Starting January 2026, you can access your long-term care benefits early if you:

- Meet the contribution requirement
- Meet the care needs requirement

We count each calendar year you worked in Washington for 500+ hours, starting July 1, 2023.

#### 2. CARE NEEDS REQUIREMENT

You must need help with **three or more** activities of daily living and will continue to need help for **90+ days**.

The activities we assess are bathing, bed mobility, eating, medication management, mobility, transferring and toileting.

# **APPLY FOR BENEFITS**

You (or someone helping you) will apply online or call us to complete your application. Your local Area Agency on Aging can support you.

Pilot participants can apply from Jan. 6 - Feb. 28, 2026. We are accepting a limited number of applications, so make sure to submit yours as soon as you can.

## RECEIVE SERVICES AND SUPPORTS

As soon as your application is approved, you can get covered services and supports from a WA Cares provider.

Your services will continue when the pilot program ends.
