



Yardwork and snow removal



Yardwork and snow removal includes help with maintaining safe access to your home by mowing, trimming branches and clearing snow and ice when needed. Yardwork and snow removal services can help you comply with any local codes or other requirements, such as with a homeowner's association.

THINGS TO CONSIDER

Covered yardwork services include raking leaves, mowing lawns, watering plants, weeding, removing yardwork debris and trimming bushes or low-hanging branches away from your home and main walkways.

Snow removal consists of removing snow and ice from sidewalks, driveways and entryways to provide safe access to your home.

WA Cares does not cover landscaping projects, indoor plant care, vegetable garden care or planting flowers, shrubs or trees.

Yardwork assistance can reduce the risk of fire or bug and pest infestation.

If you currently have a family member or friend taking on these tasks, this service can give them a break.

If you are at risk of eviction or fines for not maintaining your property according to your lease or a city code, this service can help keep your home in compliance.

PROVIDERS

The providers for these services are local or regional yardwork, yard maintenance and snow removal companies.

You can choose any WA Cares provider who is registered to provide this service. We require all providers to meet minimum qualifications. You can find a provider at wacalc.org/wacares.

RATES AND BILLING

Billing for this service will either be an hourly rate billed in 15-minute increments or as a lump sum payment, up to a monthly maximum, for agreed upon services. You will work with the provider to determine which is right for you.

Cost of services may vary based on where you live and the services you require. You and your provider will agree on a rate. You can find maximum rates and typical costs at wacaresfund.wa.gov/rates.
